State Route 6 / Franklin Road Update

NASHVILLE, Tenn. – The Tennessee Department of Transportation’s widening project of State Route 6/Franklin Road is nearing completion and is expected to be complete by the end of this year.

The following work was completed within the last week:

- Finished mainline paving
- Continued multi-use path base and surface paving
- Placed topsoil and sod throughout project
- Poured concrete driveways

The following work is expected to be completed this week:

- Finish pouring concrete driveways
- Finish (maybe) paving on multi-use path
- Pave asphalt driveways
- Place topsoil and sod throughout project
- Place ROW markers

The current lane closure of the outside northbound lane will remain in place while crews pave the multiuse path.

Motorists are advised to plan for extra travel time, and slow down while in a work zone.
