#### Historic sites within the project limits include:

(1) Cottonport which stands on the site of Mayfield Station, a fort constructed as protection from Native American raids in the late 1700's and recognized by the Williamson County Historical Society.

(2) The Carmack-Herbert Cemetery, established in 1874 and recognized by the Brentwood Historic Commission.

(3) Foxview Farm, established in 1835 and recognized by the Brentwood Historic Commission.

(4) Windy Hill Farm, established in 1830 and recognized by the Brentwood Historic Commission.

(5) Sneed Acres, established in 1798 and recognized by the Brentwood Historic Commission.
